Reflect

- Q1. a. According to Jesus in verse 31, how can we be sure that we are genuinely His disciples? What does He mean?
- b. What other indicators are there that we belong to God according to this passage? (NB verses 42, 47)
- Q2. What is it that makes us free according to Jesus? Dwell for a moment on what He says and discuss what He means.
- Q3. “Everyone who sins is a slave to sin” we’re told by Jesus in verse 34. What experiences have you had in life that demonstrate this to be true?
- Q4. a. What do we learn about the nature of the devil from verse 44?
- b. What then should we be on our guard against?
- c. How can demonic lies affect our lives?

- Q5. a. If the devil is the father of lies, and God’s truth is what sets us free, how ought that to influence the place the word of God has in our lives?
- b. What practical suggestions do you have that would help us all allow the word of God to take a central place in our lives?
